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ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

The Work permitted by this Permit shall be performed in accordance with the applicable sections of the Code of Virginia, Code of Arlington County, Virginia and all ordinances, rules, regulations, policies, and special conditions of the county and of the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia. The County Board reserves full municipal control over the subject matter of this Permit. All persons and entities performing work, installing facilities, or owning facilities in the public right-of-way under this Permit, shall be liable for all death and injury to persons and all damage to public property, improvements, facilities and utilities.

This Permit is granted subject to the following conditions to which the Permittee agrees: that the Permittee shall be responsible for all damages, injuries, and deaths caused by, or arising out of, the Work; that the Work shall be executed promptly and in such manner as to inconvenience the public in the least possible manner; that, upon completion of the Work, the roadway surfacing and all other disturbed public property, improvements, facilities and utilities shall be restored by the Permittee at no cost to the County; that if, in the future, settling of such public property, improvements, facilities, utilities or fill occurs, then such settling and related damage shall be promptly remedied by the Permittee at its sole cost and expense; that the Work shall comply with all statutes, ordinances, rules, regulations, policies, and special conditions governing such Work; and that the decision of the Director of the Department of Environmental Services, or his delegated representative, shall be binding on all questions that may arise in connection with the Work, materials, installations and facilities. At any time should the County request removal and/or relocation of facilities within the public right-of-way pursuant to this Permit, the Permittee and/or owner of such facilities shall remove and/or relocate such facilities at no cost to the County. Removal and/or relocation of facilities in the public right-of-way shall be completed within a reasonable time, as determined by the County.

The Permittee covenants to save, defend, hold, harmless, and indemnify the County, the County Board, and all of its elected and appointed officials, officers, employees, agents, departments, agencies, boards, and commissions (collectively the "County") from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, injuries, fines, penalties, costs (including court costs and attorney's fees), charges, liability, or exposure, however caused, resulting from, arising out of, or in any way connected with Permittee's intentional, negligent, or grossly negligent acts or omissions in performance or nonperformance of the Work and related activities performed by, or on behalf of, the Permittee. This indemnification shall survive the expiration of this Permit.

- Use Flashers/Barricades/Arrowboards/Signs
- Traffic Control Plan
- Advance Warning Detour Signs for Lane, Sidewalk Closed
- Flagperson, Signs, Safety Cones for Vehicular-Pedestrian
- Do Not Block Fire Hydrants/Driveways
- Reflective Tape/Reflective Cones-Fixed Objects for Night Safety
